ACESF Provides Assistance to Families of IDOC Staff Killed During Escape Attempt



Anamosa State Penitentiary

On March 23rd, 2021 two employees with the Iowa Department of Corrections were killed at Anamosa

State Penitentiary in Anamosa, IA during an inmate escape attempt. The employees identified in the attack were 50-year old Health Services Nurse Lorena Schulte of Cedar Rapids and 46-year old Correctional Officer Robert McFarland of Ely. Both Schulte and McFarland had been employed with IDOC for over 10 years. Upon learning of this tragic event, the ACESF Board voted to provide monetary assistance to both the Schulte and McFarland families. In response to the donation, IDOC Director Beth Skinner expressed appreciation for ACESF's "kind and thoughtful" gesture.

ACESF Donates to Alabama Sheriff's Youth Ranches

No doubt all Alabamians were saddened at the news of the horrific traffic crash on I-65 near Greenville last month that claimed the lives of nine children and 1 adult. Four of the victims were girls from the Alabama Sheriff's Girls Ranch in Camp Hill, and four others were related to the Ranch's Director who survived the crash. Since the ACESF participates in United Way's State Combined Campaign, the Fund is obliged to distribute a portion of its proceeds to non-ADOC charitable opportunities. Upon learning of the tragic accident, the ACESF Board determined this was a situation worthy of support and voted to make a \$1,000 contribution to the Alabama Sheriff's Youth Ranches to assist them with counseling and other needs related to this devastating event.

Scarlotte Robinson Resigns as ACESF President

Last month Scarlotte Robinson advised the ACESF Board that she would be resigning from her position as President. Scarlotte retired from ADOC in March of this year and recently accepted full-time employment in the private sector. She indicated "learning the ropes" of her new position was going to be somewhat time consuming and felt that it was best that she resign from the Board.
